


Stay Connected to Dublin and Beyond

Live on the "Right Side of Town"




Race Day Is Just the Start



A Tradition of Excellence

Known by its grand entrance and oxidized copper roof, Lawlor's Hotel is a staple for locals and visitors. The property started out as a tea-room in 1913 and progressed to a famous hotel catering for all the large racecourses in Ireland. Lawlor's quickly became the largest outdoor catering organisation in Ireland, attracting passing traffic, especially on Croke Park match days. The hotel was a landmark for travellers leaving Dublin heading south or west. The business traditionally employed staff from the town and area, a proud tradition that continues today.



Lawlor's owner Jack Tierney describes a typical evening at the Hotel as a delight for the senses. Indulge in delectable cuisine from the Bistro or Vi's Restaurant and savour drinks from the iconic Vi's bar, the Random Inn, or the original bar. As the night unfolds, the atmosphere comes alive with lively music, creating a vibrant ambiance to complement your dining experience.

Throughout the years, Lawlor's Hotel has played host to numerous memorable guests and events. The old sales books still hold the names of local dignitaries such as De Burg, Lord Palmerston, De Roberts, Moores, and many more, showcasing the rich history and importance of the hotel in the community.

Naas is an unrivalled haven for food and drink enthusiasts. Find an array of fresh, seasonal produce at Swans on the Green, a local family-run greengrocers, delicatessen and coffee shop.
